### INITIATIVES DURING THE H1N1 OUTBREAK

Archbishop Collins has asked us to implement the following temporary initiatives for the duration of the H1N1 virus season.

- Discontinue communion under both species for all except the presider and deacon.
- Suspend the practice of receiving communion on the tongue.
- Rather than shaking hands at the sign of peace offer another appropriate gesture.
- Ministers of Communion will sanitize their hands at the credence table before and after communion.
- MOST IMPORTANTLY - If you are sick, please do not attend mass. It is never morally wrong to miss mass for a serious reason. Illness is a serious reason.

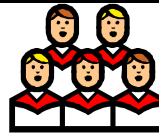
### CELEBRATING FR. FRANK'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY

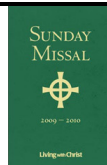
### KING EDWARD CHOIR
